Hot Springs County River and Stream Awareness Level Is Raised To Yellow

Recent rains and snow in the high country could now change conditions rapidly and unexpectedly.

Runoff from the Wind River Range could cause increases in release flows from Boysen Dam.

Melting snow could cause creeks fed by the Southern Absorokas to reach much higher flows.

As temperatures warm, Thunderstorm activity will likely increase. Heavy rains on already wet soils can lead to flooding and flash flooding.
